Purpose

- An incentive for students to be interested in the asphalt paving industry

Eligibility

- The scholarship program currently provides funding for undergraduate or graduate students. Applicants must be U.S. citizens and enrolled full-time at an accredited four-year college or university or two-year technical institution in Michigan and interested in pursuing a career in the HMA Paving Industry.
- Financial need will not be considered and scholarship awards are renewable up to two years or graduation, whichever occurs first, on the basis of satisfactory academic performance and continued eligibility for the program.

Selection

- Participants in the APAM Scholarship Program will be selected utilizing standard recipient selection procedures as developed by the Selection Committee of the APAM Scholarship Fund based on application.
- Selection criteria include consideration of past academic performance and future potential, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational aspirations, goals, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal.

Please submit, along with your completed application, no more than a one page essay on why you feel you deserve this Asphalt Paving Industry Scholarship, do you have any experience in the HMA Industry, why you are applying for this scholarship, what your plans are for after graduation and how giving you this Scholarship will benefit the HMA Paving Industry.
